Each book in the series will be titled "*LISA – Destination...*" The destination will vary depending on the location where the project is being carried out.

This is the third book in the series, made possible through the invaluable collaboration of the NGO Isla ng Bata, its dedicated volunteers who gathered the girls' stories and drawings, and Claudia Costa, who embraced the project from the beginning and supported us throughout every stage.

The project is a work in progress, and we are eager to welcome new collaborations to mark new destinations on the world map and collect more stories.
